

Flint in the South Midlands: Training Workshop

Saturday 16th November 2019

MOLA, Kent House, 30 Billing Road, Northampton NN1 5DQ

This course aims to provide a general hands-on introduction to flint, examining the sort of material that might be encountered in the South Midlands area. Topics covered by the course will include:

- Recognising worked flint
- Identifying flint by tool types and period
- How to record the flints you've found
- Case studies

The course will use examples of flint recovered from excavations in the region. Tuition will be led by Dr Bill Boismier (freelance specialist) and Dr Yvonne Wolfram-Murray (flint specialist at MOLA).

The course will run from 10:30am to 3:30pm, with a break for lunch. Participants are advised to bring their lunch with them, although there are shops within a 10 minute walk. Free tea and coffee will be provided in the MOLA office. The attached maps show how to find the venue.



Tuition fees for the day are £10 (those in full-time education can attend for free), with the numbers limited to 20 people. The course is aimed at amateur archaeologists, whose bookings will be given priority, though professionals can have their names added to a list of reserves in case of vacancies. You are advised to book early, and check on availability before sending payment.

Free car parking is available at the venue, though spaces are limited, so car-sharing is encouraged.

Please feel free to bring a few flints for identification (not more than 30 items).


