Walking in a guided group in the countryside	Animals	All	Warn participants at start if walking through fields with farm animals	Leader/ Individual
	Inclement weather or thorny/stinging vegetation	All	<ul> <li>Check forecast – be prepared to cancel</li> <li>Advise appropriate clothing if muddy/wet ground or thorny/ stinging vegetation expected</li> <li>Wear suitable clothing</li> </ul>	Leader/s Individual
Participant	Participant is unwell/injured	All	<ul> <li>Be aware of participants with health problems</li> <li>Carry first aid kit and mobile phone</li> <li>Have back marker/assistant who can lead if group has to split up</li> <li>Take reasonable measures for own health</li> <li>Make sure any national health guidelines are complied with</li> </ul>	Leader/ Individual
